The "room within a room" is a concept Vitra has been working on for some time now with the designers Ronan and Erwan Bourellec. The idea of mobile, micro-architectural elements has initiated a number of different designs, the most remarkable of which is the Alcove Sofa.

It was designed for the open-plan office, where it offers employees a comfortable, upholstered niche which protects them from the hectic goings on around them.

This makes it the perfect place to retreat to for concentrated work or meetings in small groups.

The members of the Alcove Sofa Family can be easily combined and create a versatile set of options for dividing open office landscapes without permanent fixtures. This makes it possible to set up entire central areas within open-plan offices — for meet & retreat — with a uniform aesthetic.

Depending on the product, the back and side panels are 94 cm, 136 cm (Highback) and 187 cm (Xtra High) high. In addition to the soft "lounge upholstery", they come in a firmer "work upholstery" version which makes it easier to sit up straight.

This effect is even more pronounced when two sofas are positioned across from each other. Now Vitra offers two different upholstery options — lounge upholstery and work upholstery — with different seat heights.









Alcove Two-Seater, work upholstery





It offers visual and acoustic isolation for four to six people — especially the version with extra-high side walls.


On the inside, Alcove Cabin is a complete workspace with two facing padded seats and the option of integrating a table, as well as electrification and lighting. Alcove Cabin can be combined with the Alcove Sofas and Alcove Meet and is part of a versatile set of options for dividing open office landscapes without permanent fixtures.










Alcove Cabin Highback Two-Seater



Alcove Meet is a table for up to four people with two upholstered side walls to provide a certain amount of isolation. For open-plan offices, this creates the optimal conditions for spontaneous and planned meetings. Several tables can be connected together in a row to create entire meeting zones.

Alcove Meet is useful for combining the Alcove Sofas and Alcove Cabin and is part of a versatile set of options for dividing open office landscapes without permanent fixtures.




Alcove Highback Work

The Alcove Highback Work Sofa, with its high sides and back panels, is more than just a piece of furniture. Seated in it, one is in a space of one's own and is shielded from both visual and acoustic stimuli. The integrated writing shelf made of non-slip leather, the storage space beneath it, as well as the ability to connect cables make Alcove Highback Work a flexible place to retreat to for concentrated individual work in an open-plan office. Place two Alcove Highback Work units across from each other to create a "meeting room" for two.

Materials:

- Frame/supporting structure: polished chrome tubular steel, metal frame with belt upholstery
- Carcass: high back and side panels for visual and acoustic isolation, including integrated fibreglass-reinforced plastic, connected by zip fasteners
- Seat and backrest cushions: polyurethane foam and polyester wadding
- **Drawer:** MDF carcass with polyurethane foam padding
- **Shelf:** two glued and leather-covered MDF boards


Alcove System

A sofa can become a room of its own within a room. This is especially true of the Alcove Highback Sofa System, whose side and back panels tower over the heads of those sitting in it. Thanks to the outstanding acoustic qualities of the sofa system and its function as a visual screen, it creates a truly peaceful oasis — especially in spacious areas (lobbies, lounges, halls, etc.). The system consists of three modules: a corner element, a central element and a right and left side element.

Materials:


- Supporting structure: tubular steel with belt upholstery
- Carcass: very high back and side panels for visual and acoustic isolation, with incorporated MDF panel, connected by zip fasteners
- **Upholstery/seat:** polyurethane foam and polyester wadding
- Backrest cushions and set of cushions: polyurethane chips and microfibre filling; the set of cushions is available separately
- Covers: removable
- **Legs:** polished chrome tubular steel with threaded adjustment

Alcove Table


Seated on the Alcove Highback Sofa, the occupant can hardly be seen or heard. Ronan and Erwan Bouroullec kept this idea in mind when creating their Alcove Table to be combined with the Alcove Sofa to create a small meeting room.

Users can work or hold meetings in comfort in the Alcove Highback Sofa, even for longer periods of time thanks to the adapted height of the Alcove Table. Ideally, the Alcove Table is placed between two Alcove Highback Sofas positioned closely across from each other. Thanks to the T-shaped table base, users have no trouble getting to the sofas.

Materials

- Table top: melamine faced in soft light or wood veneer in light or dark oak
- Base: tubular steel with chromed leg
